How are 250 Districts calculated?

 10 Clubs X \$250= 2,500-Therefore a District's goal is \$2,500 if there are 10 clubs in their District



Annual donations given by clubs for **active** members How are club Pacesetter donations calculated?

- 10 active members X \$10= \$100




We fit and distributed bicycle helmets for the 3rd graders at Roberts Elementary School.
